The focus of this workshop will be to work on problem areas such as: alerting on scent but not going to source, going to source, but not alerting, and rough handling of scent sources by the K9 (digging, biting, etc.) There will also be an emphasis on observing your K9s change of behavior in a variety of unusual and more difficult scent pictures. Scent sources will range from dry bones to fresh blood. There will be multiple practical applications, Q and A session, opportunities to learn from watching other K9 teams.
